

Clothing Considerations For Sedona Photo Sessions

I'm so excited that we're going to Sedona for your photo session and want you to have the very best time as well as photos you are going to absolutely love. To ensure your best experience, additional consideration needs to be taken for the kind of environment we are going to be in.

Many areas of Sedona are rugged, making sturdy shoes mandatory. Plan to wear shoes with good tread and support. Many people opt for hiking boots to protect their feet and ankles. The red soil that makes the rocks so dramatic is loose on the ground and can stick to clothing. Wearing clothes that brush off easily and hide stains are the best option here. Jeans definitely work as well as any mid-tone slacks.

Dress in layers or at least pack it along...while it can be very warm in Sedona, when the breeze comes up, or the sun starts going down, cold can set in very fast.

A second set of clothes/shoes are a good idea. You never know when a mis-step could land you in the creek or a bit of mud. Also, don't forget the sunscreen!

As with any outdoor photo session, you'll need also to prepare with the following:

Coordinate your clothes between all people involved in the session as well as considering the colors in the room you plan to hang your portrait in. While you don't have to "match", certainly you should be in similar colors that don't clash.

Solid colors only, please. No prints, logos or any other graphics as they detract from the overall quality of the photos.

Style everyone's hair at home and please do use hairspray. It is often breezy outdoors

and the photographer cannot be responsible for hairstyle malfunctions ;-D. Do make-up naturally and bring it along, as well as a comb or brush and that can of hairspray.

A special note to brides: so much fun to do a next day or trash the dress session here.



Beautiful accessories are great here, so do bring that vintage stole from your grandmother or a colorful parasol. Have your groom wear just his tuxedo shirt open with a pair of stone-washed jeans for a timeless rockstar look.
